1. Common

Cycling Finland uses the SuomiSport system to purchase licenses and insurance.

SuomiSport, produced by the Olympic Committee, is a common, modern and easy-to-use digital sports service for the entire sports community.

At SuomiSport, you will find sporting events that interest you and register for them quickly. Through the Pal service, you can acquire and pay for competition licenses, insurance, as well as club membership fees and other products. The SuomiSport application can be used with a browser or its own mobile application.



Integrations have been built from the SuomiSport system for the purchase of OP insurance policies, as well as with the UCI (International Cycling Association) information system, where athletes, judges and staff attending international events are registered. The UCI requires the so-called UCI ID that entitles you to participate in the competition.

It is extremely important that this guide is followed when purchasing licenses and insurance. If purchases are made in a way that deviates from the instructions, Cycling Finland cannot guarantee that the license insurance or other products will be delivered to the athlete on time!

2. Purchase a license and insurance

Obtaining a competition license requires that you belong to a club that is subject to Finnish cycling. The club must have paid the membership fee for that period. In this case, the club can be selected at the time of purchase.






3. If you need an international competition license or will be competing in Finnish Championships – if you do not need to, skip this

The UCI ID is implemented over the integration in the UCI system. To collect the information required by the UCI ID, the user must participate in an event called UCI Rekisteröinti. Note! Failure to do so will prevent the user from creating or updating a UCI-license for the following period. Therefore, the "UCI-rekisteröinti" event must be done once every season the user wishes to compete internationally or in Finnish Championships.

In SuomiSport, go to the "blocked events" page and select an event called UCI registration SuomiSport does not currently support making a UCI-defined card. The card is made by Cycling Finland and sent to the subscriber. Please note that there are limited resources for making the card. Try to get a License and Card well in advance.

Creating or updating a UCI ID takes max. 1 hour. After this, the UCI-ID will appear on your SuomiSport profile (NOTE: you will not receive an ID in your email).


4. Buy a picture card
