Remarks:

Only team entries will be accepted. Entitled to start are: national teams, regional teams and club teams. A team consists of 3 or 4 riders. In a team all riders exclusively have to be part of one of the following categories:

- U13f/m age groups 2011, 2012
- U15f age groups 2009, 2010
- U15m age groups 2009, 2010

The tour will be run according to the rules of the UCI and the BDR.

The number of participating riders is limited. If the number of applicants is too high the organizer will select the teams and if necessary, put the remaining places up in a draw.

Teams get their participation confirmed by 30/7/2023 and will be sent the roadbook (technical guide) by then. Rejected teams will be notified.

All teams are obliged to let the organizer know the names of the participating athletes no later than 15/8/2023. Please use the official form for this! (download from www.tour-de-berlin.de).


Transponders and start numbers will be issued before the start of the 1st stage teamwise and to the team manager only. Transponders and start numbers will be returned by the teams after the last race.

Material regulations:

For all stages the material regulations of the competition regulations for road cycling of the BDR (https://static.rad-net.de/html/verwaltung/reglements/wb-strasse_2022_v2.pdf) point 4.2 paragraph 2; paragraph 4 and 4.3 paragraph 4 must be observed.

In case of violation, 2 penalty seconds will be imposed for each kilometer ridden.



BDR Material Regulations 4.2

In the female and male junior categories young riders (U17, U15, U13) the use of the following materials is generally not permitted, even in time trial.

- wheels with less than 12 spokes and disc wheels
- so-called horn, delta or triathlon handlebars
- Handlebar attachments of any kind

If morphologically necessary, 24-inch wheels with at least 24 spokes may be used in the U15 and U13 age groups.

Material regulations of the BDR 4.3 (paragraph 4)

Permitted maximum gear ratios:

- U 13 5.66 m
- U 15 6.10 m

Only the length of the run-off is decisive for the verification of the gear ratio limitations. The run-off length is the distance covered by a wheel in one complete crank revolution.

If larger gear ratios would be possible on the road bike used, the maximum permissible gear ratio can be adjusted by a mechanical blockade. However, simply blocking the smaller sprockets (larger ratios) by means of an adjusting screw is not permitted due to the risk of manipulation.

The gear ratio and wheel control for each rider will be carried out in the individual time trial and team time trial before the start. In the mass start competitions, the first 20 of each race immediately after the finish.

The jerseys awarded:

- **Yellow** – overall leader (in each class)
- **Green** – sprint leader (in each class)
- **White** – jersey for the best rider of the younger age group in the overall classification (in each class)
- **Red** - jersey for the most combative or fairest rider of the race day. One girl and one boy will be honored per race day across all classes

Ranking overview:

Overall rankings in all classes for individual, sprint and junior (younger age group). The overall individual classification is based on time. On all stages except the time trial bonus seconds will be credited to the first riders and in intermediate sprints.

The best three teams in each class will be awarded as teams winners after the end of the race.

In all classes the green jersey will be awarded to the sprint leader.

In all classes the white jersey will be awarded to the best ranked rider of the younger age group in the general classification.

For each stage, the most combative or fairest rider(s) will be chosen by the jury and awarded the red jersey (one red jersey will be awarded per race day among all male participants and one red jersey among all female participants). The jersey will be awarded directly at the start of the next race and may be worn on the commencing stage.

Additional regulations:

In the mass start competitions, there will be a registration check before the start, which will be closed 10 minutes prior to the start.

Electronic devices for communication (e.g. radio) are prohibited.






Stage 1a) Individual time trial

 Length: 10km/8km (U13, shortened)


Stage 1b) Lap race „On the former airport of Gatow“





Sprint classification/youth classification


Only the winner's jersey for the winner in each class.
